The District is the lead agency for the CD IV project FEIR.

The District's APCO is the official that will certify the FEIR and issue the ATC. The District Governing Board has received and reviewed public comments and will make an advisory recommendation to the APCO regarding FEIR and ATC. The project involves the construction and operation of a 33 MW binary geothermal power plant and the drilling of up to sixteen new geothermal extraction and injection wells, as well as the construction and utilization of pipelines to transport the geothermal fluid and an electric transmission line to connect the facility to the existing Southern California Edison substation. The project is located on the east and west sides of US Hwy 395 at State Route 203 near Mammoth Lakes, California.
