COMMENT ON THE DISTRICT'S DECISION TO
ALLOW MODIFICATION TO AND OPERATION
OF TWO EXISTING 12 MW GEOTHERMAL
POWER PLANTS, KNOWN AS G2 AND G3, AT
CASA DIABLO KNOWN GEOTHERMAL
RESOURCE AREA (MAMMOTH PACIFIC)**

Pursuant to District Rule 205, the District solicits public comment on proposed modifications to be granted to Mammoth Pacific, L.P. for the G2 and G3 plants, two existing 12 MW geothermal power plants within the Casa Diablo Known Geothermal Resource Area off US 395 at State Route 203, Mammoth Lakes, CA. The modifications to G2 include; removal of piping to G3. The modifications to G3 include; upgrading of equipment and changing the working fluid. The modifications to the plants will not increase air pollutant emissions; therefore these modifications are exempt from the review requirements of District Rule 216. Proposed permit conditions and supporting documents are available for inspection at the District office. The facility will be operated in compliance with all district, state and federal air quality standards and regulations.
