THE GREAT BASIN UNIFIED AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT REQUESTS PUBLIC COMMENT ON THE DISTRICT'S DECISION TO ALLOW CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF TWO EMERGENCY GENERATORS FOR VERIZON

Pursuant to District Rule 205, the District solicits public comment on proposed permits to be granted to Verizon for two 157 HP diesel-fueled emergency generators, one is on Poverty Hills [about 9 miles south of Big Pine], and one is 1/4 mile south of Hunter Avenue in Chalfant [west side of Hwy 395]. Both are Caterpillar engines manufactured in 2013.

Proposed permit conditions and supporting documents are available for inspection at the District office. The facility will be operated in compliance with all district, state and federal air quality standards and regulations. The District will accept written comments in its office until the close of business on November 23, 2015.
